

PREFACE TO
GOD, ALIENS OR ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE:
WHO WROTE THE TORAH CODE?

I began my Torah Codes research in 1997 after reading Michael Drosnin's bestselling book, THE BIBLE CODE. By the time I began to write this manuscript on December 30, 2024 I had accumulated a huge wealth of data including thousands of Torah Code matrices to prove that there is indeed a predictive Equidistant Letter Sequence (ELS) Code in the Torah (the first 5 books of the Bible). What remained unclear after 28 years of Torah Codes research is the Source of that Code. When I started this new analysis there were **three suspect Authors: God, Aliens, or a military Artificial Intelligence (AI) positioned somewhere in our future.** Such an AI must be capable of either transporting data or people across time.

As a modern Orthodox Jew, I have a fairly accurate idea of what traditional Judaism has to say about the nature of God. Although Christianity and Islam trace their roots to Judaism there are significant differences. Christianity has a Trinitarian concept of God. Like Islam, Judaism rejects that understanding. The Muslim Quran goes so far as to label this idea as blasphemy. Specifically, the Koran in surah 4:171 states that:

Believing in a Trinity (i.e., God being one of three) is a form of disbelief and blasphemy. It asserts that there is only one God, Allah, and that those who claim otherwise will face a painful punishment. The Quran also emphasizes that Jesus was a messenger of God, not God himself.

Yet, the Quran endorses the belief that Jesus was the Messiah and that he was born to a virgin. Judaism totally rejects Jesus, the New Testament plus Mohammed and his Quran too. It requires anyone who claims to be a messiah to prove his case by ending all war on Earth permanently. He must also keep everyone from accepting anyone who claims to be God or endorses anyone who accepts a god not accepted by Judaism. The Jewish God is basically the Father

of Christianity. There is no need to distinguish between Him and the Holy Spirit because God is (we believe) obviously a holy Spirit.

In recent years people have begun to ask if aliens had anything to do with our history. The Raëlism religion holds that extraterrestrials, known as the [Elohim](#), created humanity using advanced technology. This atheistic religion views the Elohim as the original creators who were later mistaken for gods. In part they arrived at this belief because the second word in the Bible (Torah) is Elohim which is usually seen as being plural because of its *im* ending. Other groups, like Heaven's Gate, also believed in godlike aliens and the possibility of being taken to the heavens by a spaceship. These groups are often considered [UFO religions](#) and believe in ancient and present-day contact with extraterrestrial intelligence.

In this book I will present strong evidence proving ancient and present-day contact with ETs, but the evidence does not prove that they created the universe. When I say that I have strong evidence, I mean nothing less than a detailed account of my contact with a man who claims to be an ET. The "man" (who calls himself Craig Ebrahimi) comes with a 27-pound meteorite with what appear to be 16 fossilized alien embryos embedded in it. This object has been subject to numerous chemical tests and there are multiple PhDs who have been analyzing it since he found it in 2018. Craig is shown and my study of him is presented in Chapter 5, *First Contact with an Extraterrestrial*. That you may see why I take him seriously; Chapter 7 is *Emails to and from an ET*. In 45 pages, it presents over a year's worth of emails between Craig, those who work on analyzing his meteorite, and me. These chapters also show why I think that Craig is the man who delivered the precursors of COVID-19 to the Chinese army via the Center for Infectious Disease Control in Tianjin, China. There are also a chapter (6) that deals with why NASA is lying to us about Martian weather, and another (8) that details primitive life forms found on Mars.

When Michael Drosnin published his first Bible Code book, he claimed that any story that was covered in the New York Times could be found in the Torah Code. What I found supports this contention. To break the Code you need to pick the right axis (first) term to start the search. This is generally about eight Hebrew letters. I rarely use less than seven or more than nine letters. Most often the term is a transliteration of the first and last name, just the last name, or a first initial and last name of the subject. However, an axis term may also be

an event, such as an atomic holocaust, a war, Islamic terrorism, or a disaster. The term is then paired with *a priori* key words in the open text, or Equidistant Letter Sequence (ELS or skip) terms with skips +/- 1 or +/- the skip of the axis term. Most often the matrix has less than 1,000 letters in area (rows times columns) out of the 304,805 letters of Torah. In general, the matrix is followed by a spreadsheet showing what the odds are against such a find.

This book focuses on what the Code says about key politicians. There is a chapter about the Obama/Biden years and another about President Trump. With respect to Trump, the key people behind the impeachment attempt are all named in the Code. Kamala Harris also has a chapter. There are over 150 such matrices. My most frequent readers have been members of military intelligence, and I have been threatened for revealing what I have. The book hides nothing. It provides glimpses of our highly advanced military technology, but it does not sell short the need to consider a role for an imperfect God as our Creator.

Chapter 1 explain exactly how the Code is broken. If you are not big on math you might want to skip it and start with Chapter 2. Then, (if you are curious) come back to Chapter 1 after you have finished reading the rest of the book. You cannot use the Torah Code properly unless you download CodeFinder software.
